



Colon cancer facts

Colorectal cancer is a malignant [tumor](#) arising from the inner wall of the large intestine. Colorectal cancer is the third leading cause of [cancer](#) in [males](#) and fourth in [females](#) in the U.S. Risk factors for colorectal cancer include a family history of colorectal cancer, [colon polyps](#), and long-standing [ulcerative colitis](#). Most colorectal cancers develop from polyps. Removal of colon polyps can prevent colorectal cancer. Colon polyps and early cancer may have no symptoms. Therefore regular screening is important. Diagnosis of colorectal cancer can be made by [barium enema](#) or by [colonoscopy](#) with biopsy confirmation of cancer tissue. Treatment of colorectal cancer depends on the location, size, and extent of cancer spread, as well as the health of the patient. Surgery is the most common treatment for colorectal cancer. [Chemotherapy](#) can extend life and improve quality of life for those who have had or are living with colorectal cancer.

Colon Cancer Symptoms

Some symptoms and signs of colon cancer are blood in the stool, dark-colored stool, change in bowel habits, constipation, diarrhea, or narrow stools. Abdominal pain, cramping, or bloating may occur. Nonspecific symptoms of colon cancer can include weight loss, fatigue, weakness, and shortness of breath.

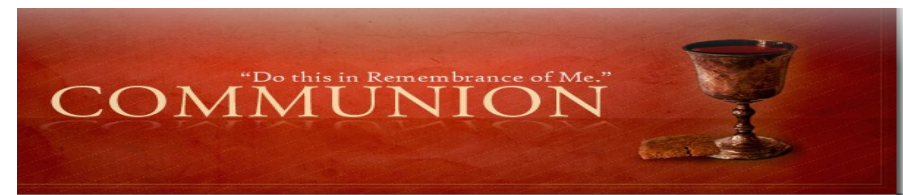
